Day Camp Sunscreen Policy

It is the parents' responsibility to apply sunscreen to their child before camp. Sunscreen is not provided by the Park District. Parents or guardians are responsible for providing their child(ren) with enough sunscreen (clearly labeled with child's name) to bring with them and apply throughout the day. In the event a camper does not bring their sunscreen to camp, they will be asked to keep their T-shirt on and remain in the shade. It is recommended that parents send **spray** sunscreen, because it is easier and less messy to apply. Counselors are required to wear protective gloves when applying sunscreen. Also, they must change gloves between camper sunscreen applications. With that said, **spray** sunscreen quickens the sunscreen application process. Campers are reminded to re-apply sunscreen before going to the Water Park and may be assigned a sunscreen buddy. Counselors will not apply sunscreen unless permission has been granted.

As the parent/legal guardian of _____, I understand and agree to the following: I am responsible for applying sunscreen to my child before sending them to camp. My child will bring a labeled sunscreen bottle to camp daily and will have the option to either apply the sunscreen to him/herself under the direct supervision of a staff member, or if needed, a staff member will be available to help my child apply sunscreen. If my child does not bring sunscreen, they may be required to remain in a shaded area for the day.
